GENERAL APPROVAL –Renewal and Clerical Modification - Tile Tech Pavers
Pedestal System and IPÊ Wood Tile on Hybrid Pedestals.

DETAILS

Tile Tech Concrete system is composed of 20 inch by 20 inch by 2 inch thick hydraulically pressed concrete pavers supported by an adjustable pedestal system.

Tile Tech Concrete Pavers are a modified concrete tile composed of crushed granite, cement and sand hydraulically pressed to produce a high psi strength paver.

Tile Tech Porcelain Pavers are composed of 24 inch by 24 inch by 3/4 inch thick porcelain designed for use in conjunction with raised pedestals and deck support systems.

Tile Tech Pedestal is composed of a uni-base, cap, insert, collar, shims and buffer pad.

Tile Tech Hex-Tray is composed of a honeycomb structural tray system, used for additional support for heights above 12" for use with Porcelain Pavers.

The components of the Tile Tech Pedestals have been tested in accordance with UBC Standards for plastic materials classification and classified as CC1.

IPÊ wood tiles are constructed from kiln dried 1x3 IPÊ wood face slats secured to 3 IPÊ wood support runners (battens) using corrosion resistant stainless steel screws. The IPÊ wood tiles are available in the following dimensions: 20" x 20" x 1-1/2", 24" x 24" x 1-5/8" and 24" x 48" x 1-5/8" (Custom Size).

Tile Tech IPÊ wood tiles have a flame spread index and smoke developed index of 20 and 400 respectively when tested in accordance with ASTM E84.

The IPÊ wood tiles meet the requirements for a "Class A" flame spread requirements when tested in accordance with ASTM E108.

The approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. The Tile Tech IPÊ wood tiles shall be installed only in areas where combustible materials are permitted by the 2017 Los Angeles Building Code.
2. The seismic stability shall be provided by detailed confinement details of the boundary of the Tile Tech Pavers System. Roof plans and confinement details shall be prepared by a CA licensed engineer or architect and submitted to structural plan check for review and approval.
3. The height of the pedestal shall be limited to maximum 24".
4. Structural observation shall be provided for the confinement of the boundary construction.
5. The materials delivered to the job site shall be identified by the manufacturer's name (Tile Tech, Inc.), the component name, RR 25746, and the name of the quality control agency.
6. The installation shall be in accordance with Tile Tech Pavers' installation manual and this report. A copy of the installation manual shall be provided on the job site.

DISCUSSION

The clerical modification is to update the report to the 2017 City of Los Angeles Building Code.

The report is in compliance with the 2017 City of Los Angeles Building Code.

The approval is based on tests. Test data is on file with the Building Research Section.
